Starnberg is located 25 km southwest of Munich and can be reached on the S6 commuter train. When you arrive at the train station Starnberg-See, take the path along the lake and the underpass to reach the museum in just 5 minutes.

If you come by car, follow the signs to the train station and museum (car park available). Parking places for the disabled are located in front of the museum on Possenhofener Strasse.

Near the museum there are several cafés and restaurants with terraces and beer gardens. The church on Schlossberg, St Josef, with its high altar by Ignaz Günther is also worth visiting. From the palace garden (Schlossgarten, not far from the church) there is a beautiful view of Starnberg and the lake. The lake and its shores offer many inviting activities: ship excursions, bathing, strolling, cycling and walking tours.
